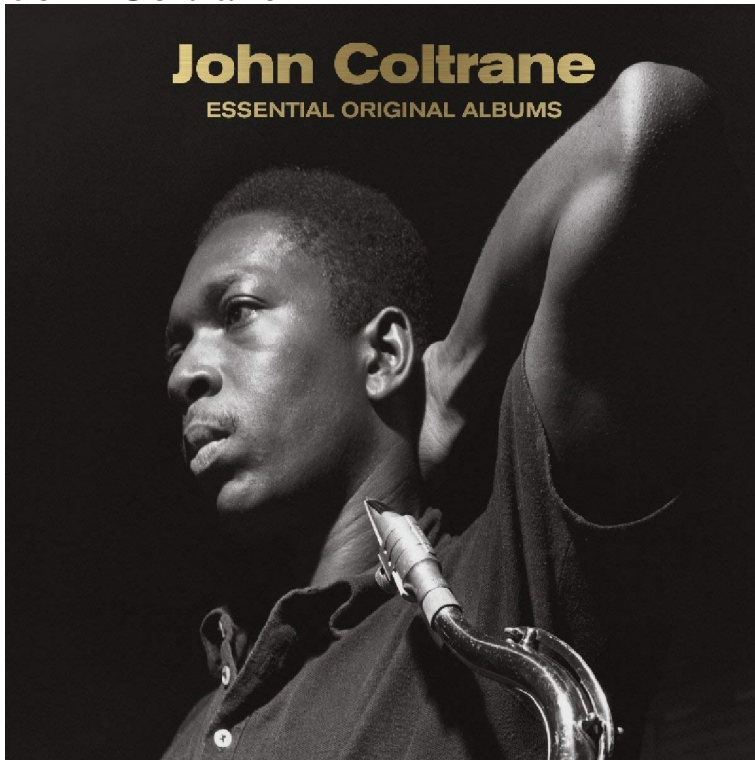


# John Coltrane



John William Coltrane (September 23, 1926 – July 17, 1967) was an American jazz saxophonist and composer, also known as "Trane". Working in the bebop and hard bop genres, he led a more or less consistent working band from 1946 to 1967.
